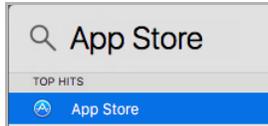
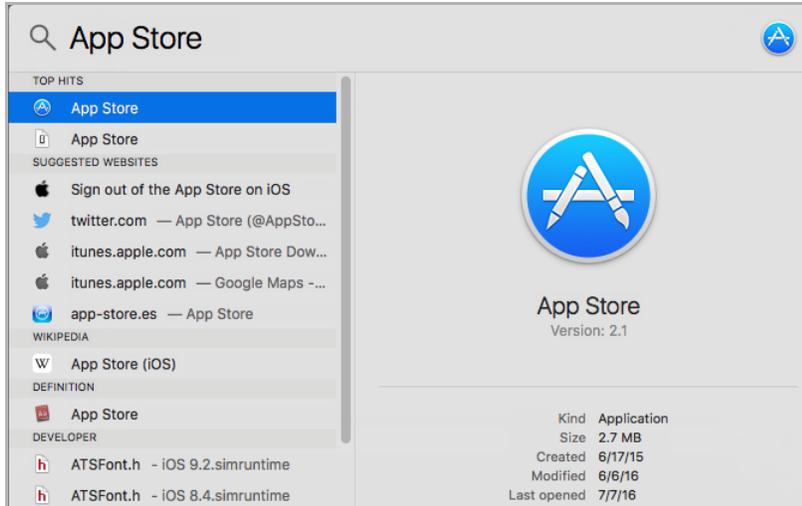


Setting Up FOUNDATION as a Remote App on a Mac

1. From your desktop, click the spotlight.

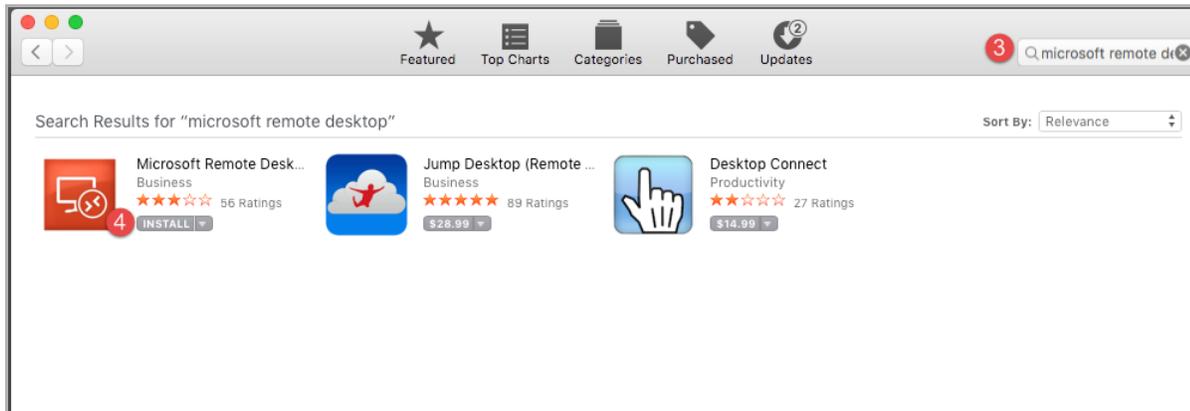


2. Search for and open the App Store.

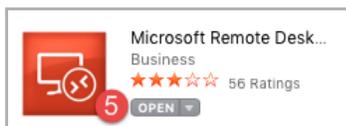


3. In the App Store, search for "Microsoft Remote Desktop."

4. Click [Install].

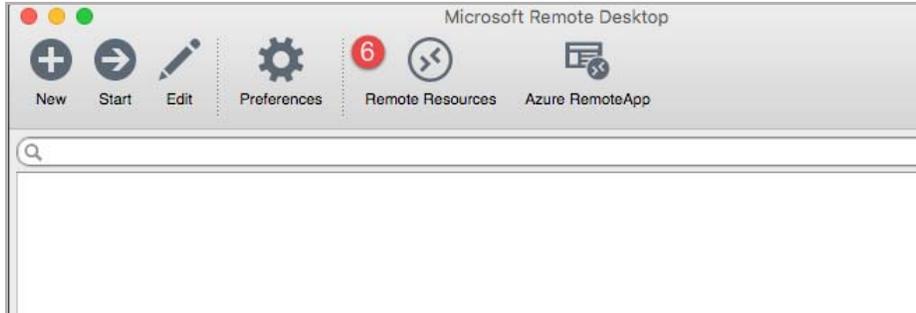


5. Open Microsoft Remote Desktop.

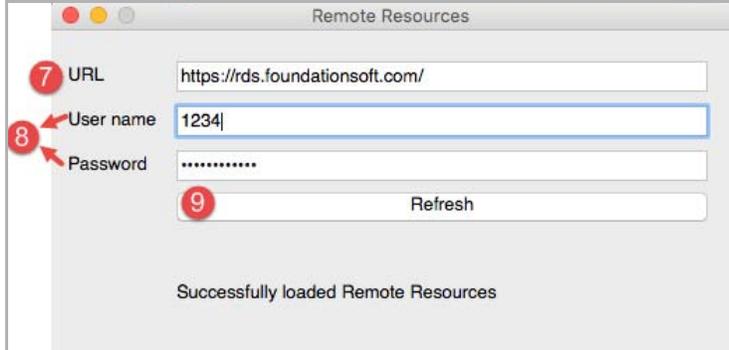

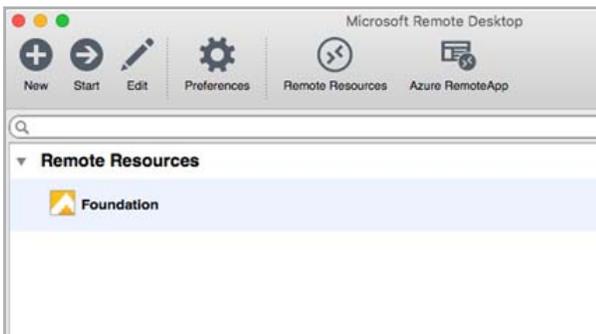
6. On the Microsoft Remote Desktop window, click on “Remote Resources.”



7. In the *URL* field, enter “https://rds.foundationsoft.com/”.
8. In the *User name* and *Password* fields, enter the username and password you use to log into the web portal.
9. Click [Refresh].
10. Close the Remote Resources pane.

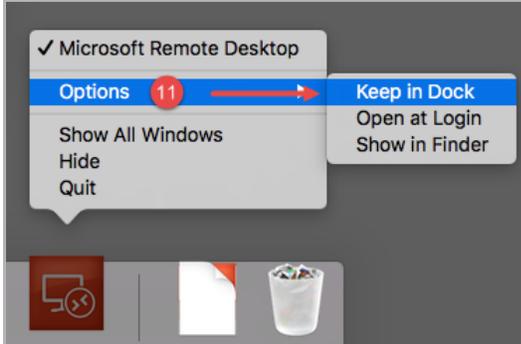


FOUNDATION is now available as a remote resource.

11. In your dock, right-click on the Microsoft Remote Desktop icon and select **Options > Keep in Dock**.

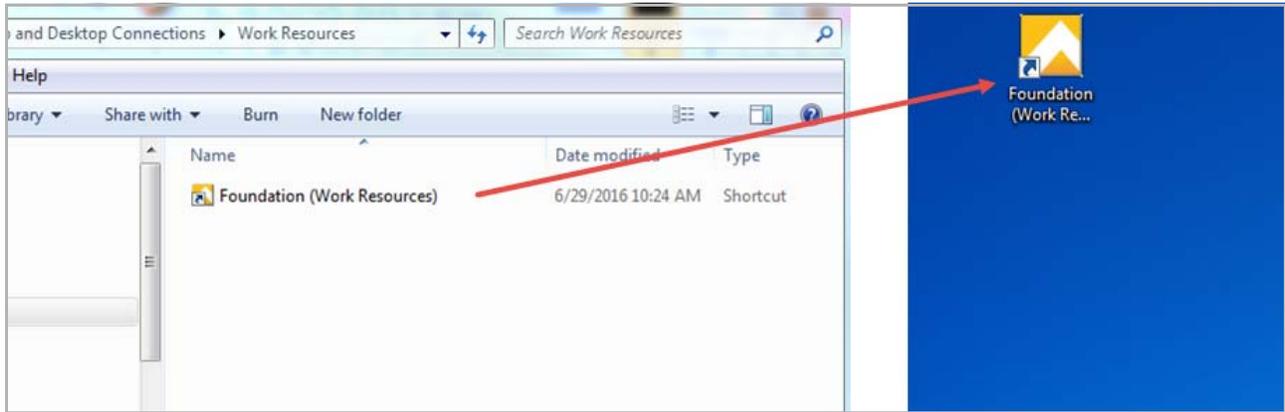


12. Double click on FOUNDATION to begin your session.

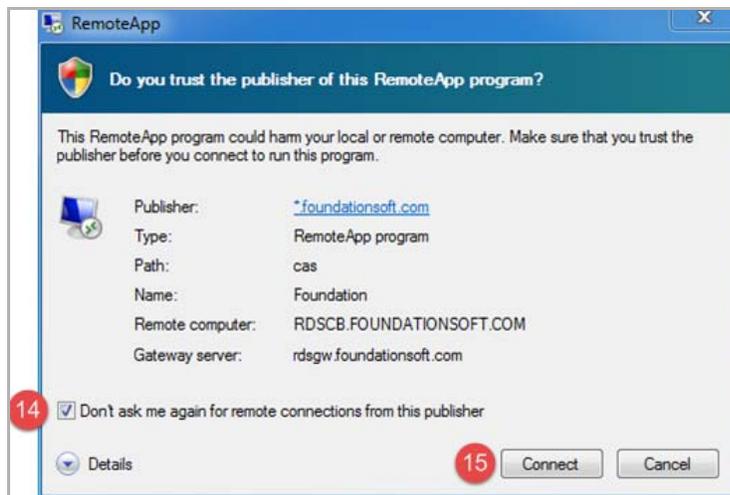

13. A new window with a FOUNDATION icon will open. Drag and drop the FOUNDATION icon onto your desktop.



14. Double click on the FOUNDATION icon.
15. A window will open asking if you trust the publisher of the RemoteApp program. Enable the *Don't Ask me again for remote connections from this publisher* checkbox.
16. Click [Connect].



17. The login window for FOUNDATION will open.
